Scholarship Award: \$350.00 / Presented by check to the graduate's school to be forwarded to the college or art school of choice.

Eligible Candidates: Graduating seniors, from Ste. Genevieve County high schools or home schools, submitting a qualified portfolio.

## PORTFOLIO GUIDELINES

Due date:	Tuesday, April 28, 2009
Where:	Office of the school counselor
Number of artworks:	Minimum – ten (10); Maximum – fifteen (15)
Preparation of artworks:	- Artwork on canvas / board need not be framed - Artworks on paper must be matted or mounted on posterboard or mat board (to protect artwork-not necessary to have mounted by a professional) - 3-dimensional work must be individually labeled & packed for transportation - Dirty, scuffed or poorly presented work will not be considered (neatness of portfolio is a consideration)
Letter of Recommendation:	Art instructor / art teacher
Return of portfolio:	By May 1, 2009 to office of the school counselor
