

Plein Aire Details

Plein aire registration is a one time fee of \$25. Any number of papers and canvases may be certified once the fee is paid. Registered painters are entitled to show and sell their work throughout the event. This includes having a vendor booth open on Saturday & Sunday. There are no commissions taken on sales from easel or booth except during the Artists & Patrons Reception.*

Registration and certification of papers and canvases will be held daily at Studio 221, corner of N. Main & Washington, from 8 am to 8 pm. Free coffee and juice will be available. Planned excursions, maps, and social events will be included in the registration packet given on arrival.

Painters and other artists who wish to participate in the Saturday & Sunday (October 10 & 11) event as vendors will be charged a booth fee of \$50. There are no commissions taken on sales from easel or booth. You must provide your own booth furniture & covering. Please reserve your space for the Art show & sale by September 25, 800.918.9199.

A special Artists & Patrons Reception & Show will be held at 188 N. Main on Thursday evening, October 8 from 6 to 8:30 pm. Plein air competition awards will be made during the reception. *Registered painters must have their completed and framed paintings turned in at 188 N. Main from 1-2 pm on Thurs, October 8.*

Artists will be asked to set their prices on the paintings along with identifying information when the pieces are turned in. *A 30% commission will be taken on any paintings sold from this exhibit.

Painting then & now...

Contemporary painters will find the same French colonial buildings, Victorian commercial structures, and extensive gardens in the downtown historic district that intrigued artists 80 years ago when Jessie Rickly established the Ste. Genevieve Artist Colony. The ragged Mississippi shoreline, midwestern farms, and remnants of old building sites still appeal. Six picturesque wineries are easily accessible by car. Hawn State Park, Pickle Springs Nature Preserve, and two tiger sanctuaries are also nearby.
